In terms of clause 9.1.4 of the UKSU Constitution, this communication serves to call for:

Please note the following from the Constitution:

- Clause 9.1.11 "Candidates for the positions of office-bearers shall have served on the Executive Committee for at least one year".
- Clause 10.2 – members of the Executive Committee "shall be eligible for re-election on termination of their period of office".

Please find attached a nomination form for the Deputy Chair position and an Executive Nomination form. All nominations must reach the UKSU Office at uksu@ukzn.c.za by 16:30 on 1 June 2021.

Copies of resolutions received, the agenda of the annual general meeting, the annual financial statement and the nominee/s for Deputy Chair and the Executive Committee will be circulated to members not less than 10 (ten) working days prior to the annual general meeting on 23 June 2021.
